Drawing Save Errors

This error usually occurs because of component conflict. Watch these steps if Sta4CAD can not save drawings:

1) Scroll to "Sta Technical Support" section from the main menu, then click the "Correct DWG drawing error". If you are using Windows Vista/2003, right click Sta4CAD and select "Run as administrator" option. Restart your machine.

2) If the problem didn't solved, go to <u>www.sta.com.tr</u> and enter the update section to download SetupDWG file. If you are using Windows Vista/2003, right click SetupDWG and select "Run as administrator" option. Restart your machine.

3) Also you can install drawing components manually. Run the Windows Command Prompt from Start > All Programs > Accessories. If you are using Windows Vista/2003, right click Command Prompt and select "Run as administrator" option. Enter the Sta4CAD directory (c:\sta4v12) from command promptIf you don't know how to use the command prompt, ask assistance from your system administrator. Then run this command: regsvr32 vdpro.ocx After the component is installed, restart your machine.

If you don't know to use command prompt, try these commands:

c: cd c:\sta4v12 regsvr32 vdpro.ocx (1 time, done to switch c drive)(1 time, to enter Sta4CAD directory)(1 time, to install components)

4) If the problem continues, you can use dxf format only. Select the DXF version 14 from the General/Project options window
